THE LEGEND: The Alba is the Phillippe Petit in our line up, balancing on the edge with poise from Pinot Gris and flair from Gewurtztraminer. The vibrant Underwood Mountain acidity is tamed with texture imbued by fermentation in concrete. All around, it is a crowd pleaser that will defy expectations.

THE TASTE: The 2022 Alba is invigorating. Flooded with exotic and fresh aromas, the fragrance of tropical locales erupts from the glass. That lushness unfurls across the palate only to be lifted up by vibrant and bouncing acidity, landing gently in a sea of delicate white blossoms.

THE PLACE: Arguably one of the most well known and sought after vineyards in the Columbia Gorge. Celilo vineyard was first planted in 1972. Situated on the Washington side of the Columbia river, at 1100 feet, on Underwood Mountain; the vineyard is primarily planted to white varieties like Chardonnay, Gewurtztramer and Pinot Gris. The 30 acre property sit primarily on deep volcanic ash and has been dry farmed since it was first planted.
